# **Our Mission**


To provide civil legal aid and advocacy to overcome unfairness and injustice to reduce poverty and increase opportunity.

  - More homeowners properties passed through generations;




# Athens Office of LASCO

#### Unmet Civil Legal Needs

- Justice Gap difference between free civil legal help available and the level necessary to meet the legal needs of low-income Americans
- LSC reported that in 2017, low-income Americans sought legal aid's help for 1.7 million civil legal problems, but 1.0-1.2 million (62%-72%) received inadequate or no legal assistance.
- That means for every 100 problems for clients served by LSC programs, between 62 and 72 of the problems are unable to receive the help they need.
